

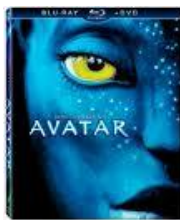

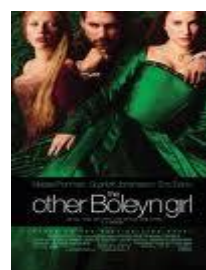
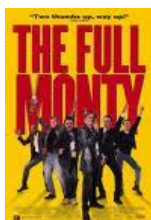


SPEAKING: Films
